Vineyards are located in Diano Castello

VARIETY

50% Syrah, 50% Grenache

VINTAGE

2020

VINIFICATION

Grapes are hand-harvested and then destemmed and crushed. The must is fermented in contact with skins for several days. Pump-overs and manual punch downs are performed periodically.

AGEING

About 6 months in stainless steel.

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 years

APPEARANCE

Garnet red with ruby hues.

ON THE NOSE

Intense perfume of black fruits such as prune, blackberry and a nice spicy note of black pepper.

ON THE PALATE

Balanced, fresh and round, with a high fruity character and slightly spicy.

FOOD PAIRING

Red meat dishes and intense cheeses.

The name Bormano finds its explanation in the toponym Lucus Bormani that echoes over the Ligurian territory in the pre-Romanesque period. Lusus means sacred clearing and Borman was the Celtic deity of the woods and warm spring waters.
